

School Meals



It has come to my attention that there a number of parents with a significant school lunch debt.

May I remind parents that as a school we are liable for these debts and we don't have sufficient spare funding to pay for them.

Therefore, if a debt remains outstanding and no communication has been made with the office to make a payment then we have no alternative but to refuse a child a full lunch. School Lunch is £2.20 + 40p for drink and it can be paid daily or in advance by cash or cheque at the office with Mrs Allan.
