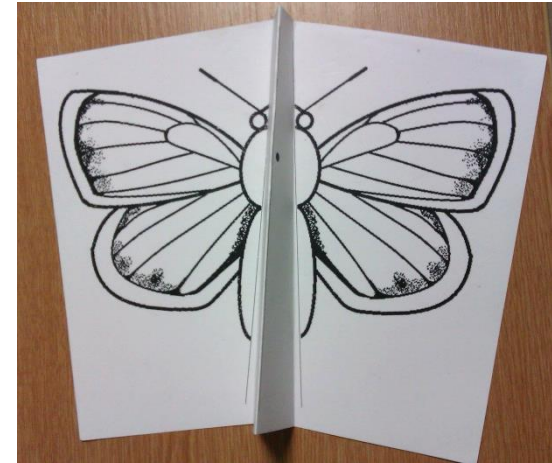
Make a Butterfly Kite

What you will need:

- White card
- Colouring pens/pencils
- Hole punch
- 1m length of string

Instructions:

1. Print the Butterfly template on to card.
2. Colour your butterfly in – if you need inspiration visit our website www.munchingcaterpillars.org and click on 'Resources' to find a page all about our common garden butterflies.
3. Once coloured in, fold your card in half along the centre line making sure that you can still see the butterfly's wings.
4. Lay flat again but this time fold each wing towards you along the diagonal lines so that your butterfly kite looks a bit like the picture above.
5. Use a holepunch to make a hole through the black dots.
6. Tie a piece of string through this hole and your kite is ready to fly!



Hey, if it's not very windy why not try running really fast and flying your kite behind you?!
