What you will need:

A large shoebox with lid.

Crafting items such as green paper, pebbles or sand and some glue.

Card, paints and scissors.

Instructions:

First draw the shapes of the animals you want in your scene. You can also draw trees if you want them.

Begin to paint the shoebox so it matches your scene. Perhaps have an african sunset as the background or clear blue skies.

Once you are happy with the design, begin to stick your animals into the scene. Use a small piece of card and fold it so it can be used to glue them in the box.
