Me and My Community



Maths:

Your child will be representing, comparing and learning about composition of numbers. They will be exploring 2D shapes and spatial awareness.

Personal Social & Emotional Development:

Your child will explore how they are unique and special. Your child will learn about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school.

Communication and Language:

Your child will have a wealth of opportunities to build confidence and develop their language skills through role play, small world and stories, rhymes and song.

Literacy:

Your child will take part in a daily phonics session and daily story session. They will have lots of opportunities for mark making and writing.

Understanding the World:

They will discover the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

Expressive Art and Design:

They will be exploring colour, texture and different ways to mark make.

Physical development:

Your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility through dance and games. They will be take part in Dough Disco which will strengthen their hand and finger muscles in preparation for early writing.



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Reading

Please read with your child every evening and record and sign any comments in your child's reading diary. Please encourage your child to handle the book correctly, turn the pages over one at a time, start at the beginning and talk about what is happening in the pictures. As your child learns letters in their phonics sessions, they will be given reading books with words in them. Books will be changed every week. Children need to bring their book bags in every day as they will read to an adult during the week.

Good to be Green

This is our school Behaviour Management scheme. Every child starts each day with a green card displayed on our class chart. Consequence cards are given to children who don't display good behaviour. Rewards are given to pupils for good behaviour.

Christian Values

Our school Christian Value for the half term is **Compassion**. We will be looking at friendship and love to show this value and how we can develop Compassion in ourselves. We will also share bible stories that demonstrate this value. Two good examples you can share with your child are the stories of 'The loaves and fishes' and 'The Good Samaritan'
