Welcome to the second half of our Autumn Term. The children are all very settled, know our daily routine and have become fantastic learners. During the last half term, the children enjoyed a visit from our local Dentist who demonstrated how to brush our teeth effectively which is so important particularly for young children. We also learned about Harvest and learned the song and actions to 'Big Red Combine Harvester'.

For our topic this term we will be continuing with 'Me and My community' and Autumn; alongside this we will be planning learning opportunities from the children's interests. We will be sharing a wide range of books, rhymes, poems and songs linked to seasonal changes and festivals. We will be thinking about Bonfire Night and how to safely enjoy ourselves. We will be learning about Diwali and Remembrance Day and learning about the significance of wearing a poppy. We will be celebrating World Nursery Rhyme Week and Children in Need. Before you know it, Christmas will be approaching and we will be planning and practising for our Nativity.

As you know a home learning activity will be set every term, this is a project for children to complete at home, alongside family and friends over several weeks. This is designed to further children's learning and understanding of the topic, as well as develop independent learning and interest. Looking ahead to Christmas and decorating our class Christmas tree, this term's home learning project is to create a Christmas decoration which we can hang on our tree. We would like the children to plan and design their decoration before creating it. This home learning project should be returned to school by Monday 29th November, this will then provide all children with the time to share their projects in class and hang it on the class Christmas tree when we put it up on 1st December. We look forward to seeing the completed decorations.

There will be weekly updates on Clee Class page on the school website every Friday showing the learning which has taken place during the week and an individual observation will be sent via Evidence Me.

Whilst in Clee, we expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, please bring their book bag in every day as we will be hearing your child read during the week. Please write a comment about how they have read in their reading diary. New books will be sent home every week.

Your child will have the opportunity to join in PE twice a week. Our PE days are a Tuesday and Thursday. We ask for all children to keep their PE kits in school. The kits will be sent home at the end of the half term to be washed.

As a church school, our learning takes place through Christian Values. This term our value is Compassion. The children will be looking at how this value links to our topics and how they can display our value in their everyday lives. If you see your child, or any member of the Holy Trinity community displaying any of our core values, we'd love to hear about it. We will be awarding children who go above and beyond to show our values a special award at the end of each term.
