Welcome to the second half of our Autumn Term, we are looking forward to the weeks ahead and starting to prepare for our Christmas performance. The children worked incredibly hard last half term and we are looking forward to them develop in their learning and understanding further. In class this half term we will be developing the skills to write a setting description, practising our capital letters and full stop and finding out about adjectives as well as exclamation and statement sentences. In Maths we will be continuing our Addition and Subtraction unit where the children will be focusing on subtraction. In Science we will be starting our Human Body unit where we will be learning about the main parts of our bodies, the 5 senses and our organs. We are looking forward to our History unit which will be focusing on our own childhoods through the use of photographs and timelines, as well as comparing childhood in the 1950s to now. In RE we will be learning about Christmas and Incarnation, which will also be supported in our Christmas production.

Whilst in Wrekin, we expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, with their book bag being returned every Friday in preparation for a new reading book to be issued. Please can you write a comment about how they have read. Spellings will be linked to the phonic sounds learnt within each child's phonics group and sent home on a Monday. Your child is expected to learn these at home ready for a test on the following Monday. Your child will have the opportunity to have PE twice a week. Our set days are a Monday and Wednesday, but due to the weather this might change. We ask for all children to keep their PE kits in school and they will be sent home at the end of the half term.

As a church school, our learning takes place through Christian Values. This term we are looking at Compassion. The children will be looking at how this value links to our learning and how they can display our value in their everyday lives. If you see your child, or any member of the Holy Trinity community displaying any of our core values, we'd love to hear about it. We will be awarding children who go above and beyond to show our values a special award at the end of each term.
