There will be weekly updates on Clee Class page on the school website every Friday showing the learning which has taken place during the week and an individual observation will be sent via Evidence Me.

Whilst in Clee, we expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, please bring their book bag in every day as we will be hearing your child read during the week. Please write a comment about how they have read in their reading diary. New books will be sent home every week.

Your child will have the opportunity to join in PE twice a week. Our PE days are a Tuesday and Thursday. We ask for all children to keep their PE kits in school. The kits will be sent home at the end of the half term to be washed.

As a church school, our learning takes place through Christian Values. This term our value is Courage. The children will be looking at how this value links to our topics and how they can display our value in their everyday lives.
