Hawkstone Newsletter Spring 1

Welcome to our Spring Term, we are looking forward to the weeks ahead and starting to see all of our skills learnt over the Autumn Term being used throughout our lessons. The children worked incredibly hard last term and we made us all incredibly proud.

In class this half term, we will be focusing on a book called 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. During this English unit we will be learning about writing in the past tense with a history focus, using conjunctions, including a variety of verb forms including the progressive and the present perfect forms. We will also be learning about inverted commas to punctuate direct speech and grouping ideas into paragraphs. All of these new skills will help us to write an adventure story from the perspective of the main character.

In Maths, we will be concentrating on our Multiplication and Division unit, recapping how to use to make equal groups, use arrays, and how to divide a number equally through sharing and grouping. We will also be revisiting our 2, 5 and 10 times tables and focusing on our 6, 7, 9 times tables. In Science, we will be focusing on Electricity in Year 4 and Forces in Year 5. We are looking forward to our Geography unit which will be focusing on Europe and its location in the world, along with countries, regions/counties. A study of Bologna in Italy will take place by making comparisons to our own lives in Oswestry. In RE we will be developing an understanding of the Islam faith, looking at their God, Allah, and what it is like to be a Muslim. In PE we will be using our Gymnastics sessions to learn how to move around the hall at different speeds and using different shapes, moving on to looking at a range of rolls to move around. In Music we will be looking at Rap songs, focusing on the beat, improvisations, instrumental performances, compositions. In Art we are learning about using a range of different media to make marks, before looking at creating different marks such as spirals.

Whilst in Hawkstone we expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, with their reading book and record being in school each day. Please can you write a comment about how they have read. Spellings will be linked our no nonsense scheme and sent home on a Friday. Your child is expected to learn these at home ready for a test on the following Friday. Your child will have the opportunity to have PE twice a week. Our set days are a Wednesday and Friday, but due to the weather this
