## Wrekin Newsletter Summer 1

Welcome to the first part of our Summer Term, we are excited about getting outside with the children as much as possible in the coming weeks to enjoy the better weather!

In class this half term we will be focusing on a book called The Last Wolf by Mini Grey. During this English unit we will be learning about writing in the 1st person, writing simple sentences in sequence, begin to link events using *and*, use simple openings and closings *e.g. dear, from*, and using apostrophes for contraction. This will culminate in writing a persuasive letter. In Maths we will be concentrating on Multiplication and Division, Factions and Geometry where we will continue to challenge the children with explaining and proving their answers. In Science we will be investigating Seasonal Changes and Weather where we will develop an understanding of how our weather changes during the seasons and how we can measure different types of weather. We are looking forward to starting our History unit which will be focusing on The Great Fire of London. In RE we will be developing our understanding of Religious Festivals. In PE we will be playing different ball games, focusing on catching and throwing the ball. In Music we will be looking at a song called Your Imagination as well as many other fun and fantastic songs such as Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious from Mary Poppins and Pure Imagination from Willy Wonka & The Chocolate Factory. In Art the children will be studying birds and will working towards creating their own bird from wire.

Whilst in Wrekin, we expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, with their book bag being returned every Friday in preparation for a new reading book to be issued. Please can you write a comment about how they have read. Spellings will be linked to the phonic sounds learnt within each child's phonics group and sent home on a Monday. Your child is expected to learn these at home ready for a test on the following Monday. Your child will have the opportunity to have PE twice a week. Our set days are a Monday and Wednesday, but due to the weather this might change. We ask for all children to keep their PE kits in school and they will be sent home at the end of the half term.
