We will be continuing to share a wide range of books, rhymes, poems and songs linked to journeys, travel, precious items and sports day. We will be doing lots of practising ready for our sports day. As you know a home learning activity is set every term, this is a project for children to complete at home, alongside family and friends over several weeks. This is designed to further children's learning and understanding of the topic, as well as develop independent learning and interest. For this half term's home learning project, I am setting them the challenge of 'interviewing' a grandparent, relative or family friend about the types of games they played when they were little or to find out what televisions, computers, cameras, cars, children's TV programmes etc used to be like. They can record this in any way they want to; drawing, writing, photographs or items. If you have any items from the past which you could share with us that would be fantastic.

There will be weekly updates on Cleo Class page on the school website every Friday showing the learning which has taken place during the week.

Whilst in Reception, please help your child to read at least 5 times a week and write a comment about how they have read in their reading diary. Please bring their book bag in every day as we will be hearing your child read during the week. New books will be sent home every week.

As a church school, our learning takes place through Christian Values. This term our value is Respect. The children will be looking at how this value links to our topics and how they can display our value in their everyday lives. If you see your child, or any member of the Holy Trinity community displaying any of our core values, we'd love to hear about it. We will be awarding children who go above and beyond to show our values a special award at the end of each term.
