Here we are at your daughter/son final term at Holy Trinity. We have already got off to a good start and have been preparing our writing, as our school has been chosen for a writing Moderation Visit on 22nd June. The children have been working so hard to edit and make their writing the best it can possibly be, before being moderated on this visit. The children worked so hard towards their SATs last term and took their tests in their stride. The results will not be sent to us now until the middle of July and will be written onto their end of term reports. We are in the middle of studying the text of *When War Came* written by Nicola Davis and will be finishing this book and looking at other texts that may be used in Year 7.

In Maths we have started to look at some investigations which cover all the skills they have learnt in their Primary years, we will also be doing some Year 7 Transition Maths in preparation for Secondary School. In Science we will be starting our Human Body unit, where we will develop an understanding of the heart and the circulatory system and effects of exercise on the heart. Our new Geography topic is a study of El Salvador, as well as finishing work on the Ancient Maya. In RE we will be studying a new unit on The Gospel. Year 6 will continue to develop their ICT skills by Programming and hopefully will be able to write their own basic computer programme by the end of term. In PSHE we will be learning about Sex Education, but further information will be sent home about the curriculum after SATS.

Reading is still as important as ever and we will still expect your child to read at least 5 times a week, writing a comment in their diary about what they have read. You are welcome to write a comment about how they have read and we encourage this. Spellings will be picked up again after the Writing Moderation. Your child is expected to learn these at home ready for a test on the following Wednesday. Your child will have the opportunity to have PE twice a week. Our set days are a Tuesday and Thursday. Tuesday is indoor and Thursday is outdoor PE. We ask for all children to keep their PE kits in school every day, as once SATs are finished, we may spend more time doing some PE and outdoor lessons.
