### Personal Social & Emotional Development:

Your child will explore how they are unique and special and value themselves as an individual. They will develop their understanding of their own and others' needs and feelings and begin to resolve conflicts.

### Physical development:

Your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility in our outdoor environment and will develop their finger strength through dough disco.

### Communication and Language:

Your child will have lots of opportunities to talk to different adults and children within our provision. They will take part in discussions and encouraged to use recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction rhymes and poems. They will be encouraged to express their ideas using full sentences.

### Literacy:

Those children who are moving into Reception in September will take part in a short daily phonics session. We have lots of story, rhyme and song sessions. We visit our school library regularly to look at and handle the books and to enjoy a range of stories.

### Maths:

Your child will be 'noticing' number in their environment. They will explore number patterns and sequences and make comparisons.

### Understanding the World:

They will create a Holy Trinity Museum and talk to family members about when they were little. They will look at travel and journeys. They will explore the world around them; learning about the seasonal changes and how to stay safe in the sun.

### Expressive Art and Design:

They will have opportunities to mark make and experiment with colour and texture. They will investigate the different sounds that can be made with percussion instruments and name some musical instruments. They will listen to a range of music from around the world.
