## Communication and Language

Your child will have a wealth of opportunities to build confidence and develop their language skills through role play, small world and stories, rhymes and song. They will join in activities planned to promote listening skills and listening to each other.



## Literacy

Your child will meet 'Fred Frog' and have lots of opportunities to 'Fred talk', this will support them to discriminate sounds in preparation for beginning Phonics in Reception.

They will have lots of opportunities for mark making and writing both indoors and outdoors. Our Literacy focus book will be 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will also have a 'book of the week' which we will read together during storytime sessions.

We will use 'Poetry Basket' daily to learn new rhymes and poems.

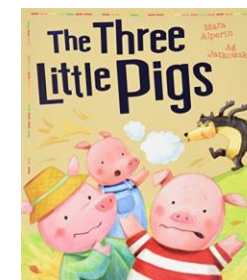
## Personal, Social and Emotional

**Self-regulation** – begin to follow instructions, and begin to recognise different emotions.

**Managing Self** – begin to understand the need to have rules, making healthy food choices

**Building relationships** – seeking support from adults when needed, developing confidence to speak to peers and adults.

Your child will explore how they are unique and special. Your child will begin learn about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school.



## Physical Development

**Gross motor skills** – your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility and learn how to move safely in a space.

**Fine motor skills** – activities to promote finger strength including dough disco and Funky Fingers.

## Understanding the World

Your child will discover the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

We will explore the natural environment around us and the seasons.

We will celebrate Remembrance Day, King Charles's 75<sup>th</sup> Birthday, Diwali and Christmas.

## Maths

The children will self register each sessions using 5 frames to support their early number sense. They will be encouraged to talk about what they see and what they notice. Their early Maths skills will be supported through a range of adult led and child led opportunities.

## Christian Values

Our school overarching Christian Value is **Hope**. Our other school values are **Dignity, Wisdom, Community, Peace and Joy**. We will be using songs, bible stories and circle times to learn what these values mean to us.

## Expressive Art and Design

Your child will be exploring colour, texture and different ways to mark make. They will be drawing, painting and making self-portraits.
