Physical Development

Gross motor skills – your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility and learn how to move safely in a space.

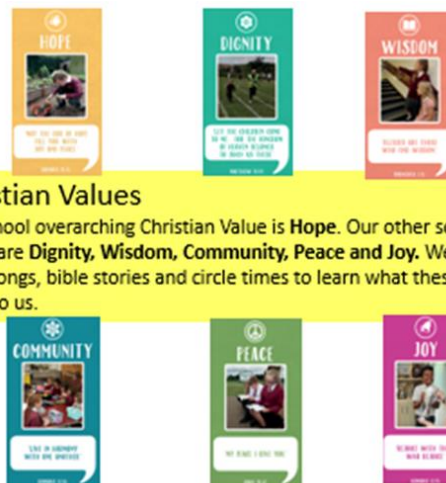


Pathways to Write



Christian Values

Literacy

When your child is ready, they will take part in a daily phonics session. They will enjoy daily story sessions. They will have lots of opportunities for mark making and writing. Our Literacy focus book will be 'Let's All Creep Through Crocodile Creek'. We will use 'Poetry Basket' daily to learn new rhymes and poems.

Maths

This half term you child will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers.



Personal, Social and Emotional

Self-regulation – talking to others about how we are feeling and develop strategies for coping with feelings

Managing Self – understanding the need to have rules, making healthy food choices and looking after our teeth

Building relationships – talking about being a good friend, what is kind and unkind. .Build on our friendships

Understanding the World

Your child will begin to talk about the relationship they have to members of their own family. They will talk about their own family and how it is unique, they will look at families in other countries.

They will explore the natural environment around us and seasonal changes.

They will celebrate St David's Day, Baba Marta Day, St Patrick's Day and Easter

Expressive Art and Design

The children will have opportunities to listen to and compose music and perform songs. They will have lots of opportunities to create artwork using a range of different media both indoors and outdoors.
