Personal, Social and Emotional

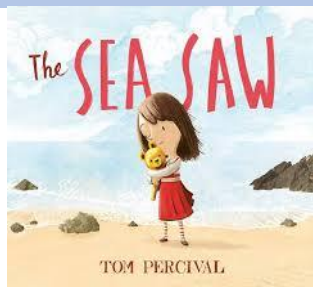
This half term, we will be looking at how we manage our emotions. We will be developing coping mechanisms for when we have big feelings: like calming ourselves when we are cross or sad. We will be thinking about the transitions in our routines and the reasons for changes.

Physical Development

Your child will have lots of opportunity to develop their strength, balance, coordination and agility through PE and games. We will be practising for our sports day. They will continue to develop pencil control in preparation for writing.

Communication and Language

We will be focussing on understanding prepositional language e.g. on, under. We will also be asking why things are happening. To challenge the children, we will be encouraging them to use a wider range of vocabulary in their play. Some of them will start singing some songs independently.

Christian Values

Our school overarching Christian Value is Hope. Our other school values are Dignity, Wisdom, Community, Peace and Joy. We will be using songs, bible stories and circle times to learn what these values mean to us.



Understanding the World

The children will be discussing who they live with and who the adults are to them. Children will be developing an idea of 'belonging'. Children beginning to understand what the 'wider world' is and how we all play a part and get along with one another. This half term, we will be growing plants from seeds and caring for them, and exploring how these plants grow and change over time.

Literacy

This half term, the children who will be starting Reception in September will begin to participate in a daily phonics session. They will start to learn all the speed sounds, using the RWI resources.

Our book this half term is The Sea Saw.

We will be starting to listen to slightly longer stories and trying to recall what has happened. We will be starting to answer simple questions about stories that we hear, as well as predicting what might happen in a story.

Maths

This half term you child will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers.

Expressive Art and Design

Children joining in with the actions to songs, children engaging in roleplay in and out of the home-corner and becoming more immersed in their play.
